Welcome to all of you! Just an early reminder of some essentials.

When to arrive:

Consult your map that is attached (F 4) to get to the classroom, **SS/PA006**, in the basement of the building (Social Science/Public Administration) which is on the corner of State University Drive and Deukmejian Street . (You can see the **SS/PA** logo on the southwest corner of the building if you look above the second story windows.) If for some reason this map does not open on your computer, google CSULB and get a map for the “east campus.”

Enter the campus from **the 405 Freeway; turn west on Palo Verde which is the first offramp from the 605 Freeway. Proceed west on Palo Verde to the dead end which is State University Drive. The Foundation parking lot (F 4) is on your left at the first stop sign (Deukmejian Street).** Parking is \$3 per day per car. Please have exact change. If you are being dropped off or picked up, there is metered parking right in front of the SS/PA building.

Please arrive each day so we can begin at 9 a.m. We have a full schedule and like to promise you a prompt start and stop time. We will conclude in time to get you on the road by 3:30 p.m.

What to bring:

Writing materials (pen, pencil, highlighter) --we provide reporter's notebooks and lined notepaper
Your school activity schedule for the **next** school year, if available
Your list of staff members for 2006-2007 and positions on the staff
Copies of several (if not all) of last year's school newspapers
Laptop computer with battery; no electrical outlets are available
Digital camera with download connecting cords
Lunch money--there are several fast-food restaurants in the nearby Student Union building; right behind the SS/PA Building, is the Outpost with breakfast from \$1.60 and lunch from \$3
